FREE SCHOOL MEALS (IMPORTANT CHANGES)

The Government has started to roll out Universal Credit and it has altered eligibility rules for Free School Meals slightly. Universal Credit will not be fully in force until March 2022 but during this transitional period there are some crucial changes which will **greatly benefit people who are currently entitled to Free School Meals and if you think you may be eligible but have not taken up your entitlement, we would urge every parent who may be eligible to apply now!**

The key changes will mean:



- Any pupil eligible for free schools meals before 1 April 2018 will keep their free school meal eligibility until **31 March 2022** : Pupils will keep their eligibility even if their circumstances change.
- Any pupil who becomes eligible during the rollout of Universal Credit (from 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2022) will keep their eligibility until 31 March 2022
- Once the rollout of Universal Credit has completed (31 March 2022), any pupil getting FSM as of the 31 March 2022 will continue to be transitionally protected until the end of their current phase of education, e.g. primary/secondary school:

What this means:

If your child is currently in Primary school but will be in Secondary in March 2022 they will continue to receive Free School Meals for the whole of their time in Secondary school!

As you can see, this is fantastic news for families, we are asking people who may be eligible for Free School Meals but who have not yet taken up the entitlement to make an application NOW! Making an application is so easy and done simply through filling in a form from our school office or website.
